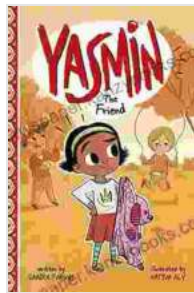


Yasmin the Friend: A Heartwarming Story About the True Meaning of Friendship

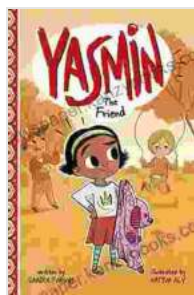

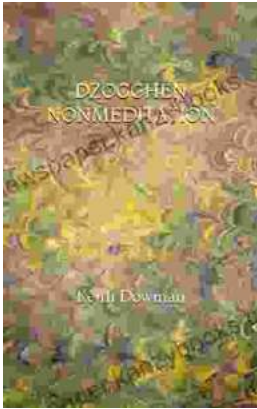
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
